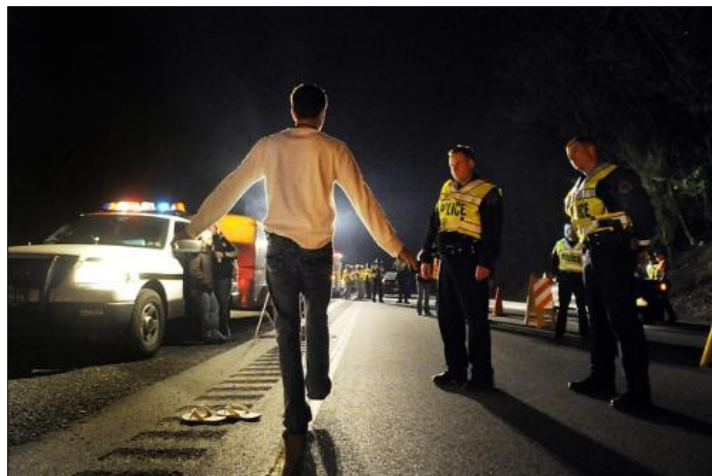

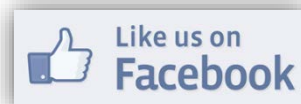


The Texas SFST Training Program offers a FREE 8-hour Fundamentals of DWI Investigation and Enforcement Course (TCOLE 3402).
