WHEREAS, The Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Lower Rio Grande Valley, namely Willacy, Cameron and Hidalgo Counties, that the Regional Law Enforcement Training and Education be operated for the 2017 -2019 fiscal years; and

WHEREAS, Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the State Criminal Justice Planning Fund grant application; and

WHEREAS, Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

WHEREAS, Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council designates Ron Garza, Executive Director of the Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council (LRGVDC), as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council Board of Directors approves submission of the grant application for the Regional Law Enforcement Training and Education to the Office of the Governor.
