When will Texas receive the funds?

For Texas to receive these funds, HUD must publish rules governing the use of the recovery dollars in the Federal Register, which enables the Texas General Land Office (GLO) to draft a state action plan.

Once drafted, the plan will be made available for a mandatory public comment period.

After the comments are responded to, the state action plan is then sent to HUD for final approval.

The federally mandated process takes a minimum of four months and has taken longer than six months in many cases.
