### THE PLAN

The Brazos Island Harbor Channel Deepening Project will deepen Brownsville Ship Channel from **42 feet to 52 feet**.

### FEDERAL FUNDING ANNOUNCED MARCH 2022:

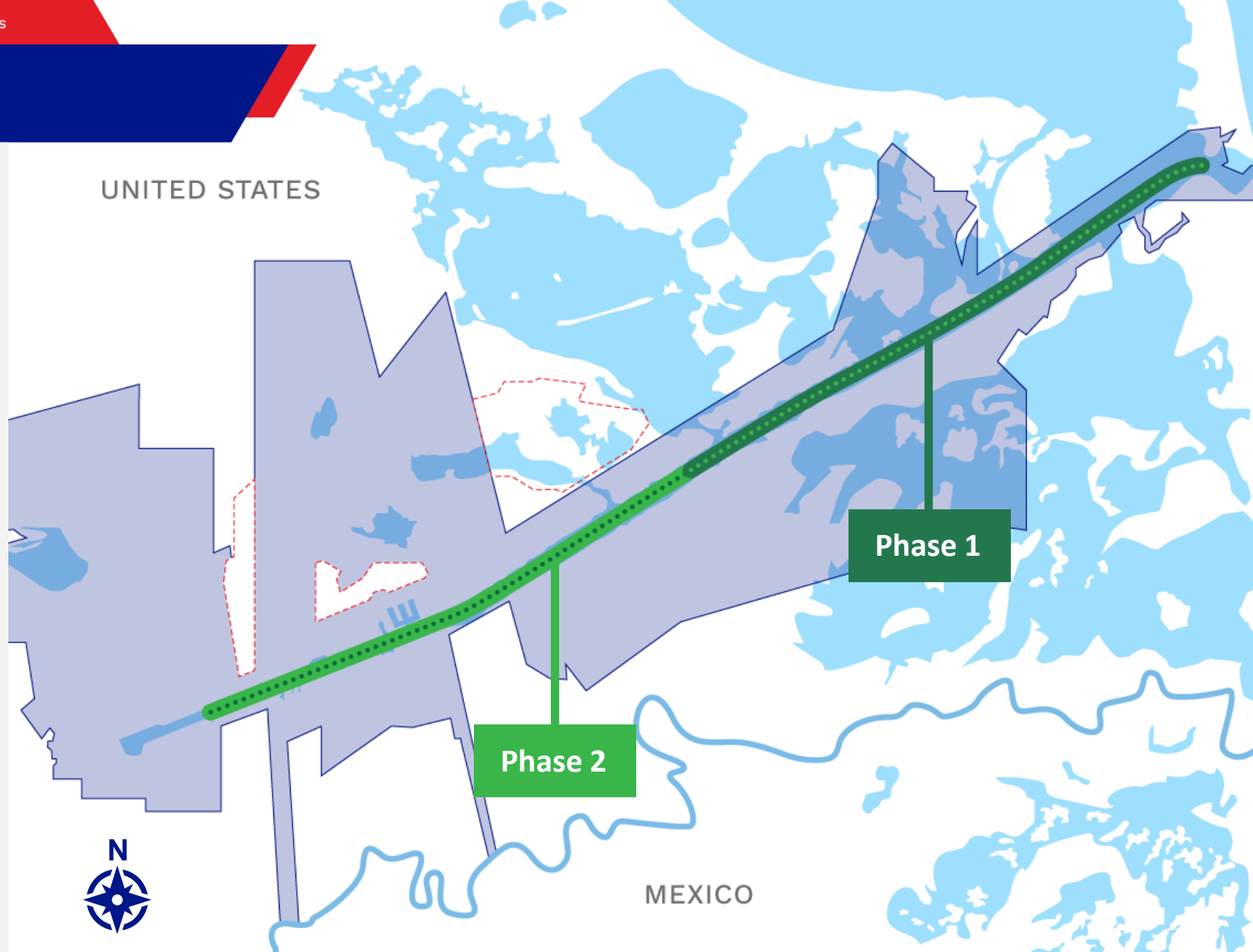
**\$68 million** under the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) Appropriations Law.

The BIH project is identified as part of the IIJA to **strengthen port and waterway supply chains and climate resilience**.

## PESQUERIA PROJECT

Began operations in Spring 2022.

Maximizes the movement of steel slab to Ternium's state-of-the-art steel mill in Pesqueria, Mexico.
