Signed <u>EO 14012</u> on Feb. 2, 2021

Directed the Federal Government to develop welcoming strategies that promote integration, inclusion, and citizenship

Section 5 - Promoting Naturalization

- Improve the naturalization process by promote naturalization through citizenship education and awareness and by building capacity and expanding partnerships.
- Establish an interagency working group (WG) to develop a national strategy.

WORKING GROUP GOALS
