




What is a Cost of Service Adjustment?

2021 RGV Cost of Service Adjustment (COSA)

COSA tariff was approved by the 34 RGV cities served by Texas Gas Service in April 2018





Why an Annual COSA?

2021 RGV Cost of Service Adjustment


- Invested over \$20 million in new or replacement infrastructure in 2020
- Leak surveyed and repaired mains and services
- In compliance with federal and state regulatory safety mandates
- Reduces time and expense associated with a general rate case

2021 RGV Cost of Service Adjustment (COSA)




Commercial Customers
