Placards


Placards are signs placed on the interior of our buses, made of high quality glossy card stock and measuring 11" x 17" in landscape orientation. These placards are a great way to advertise your business to a constantly revolving audience. They are placed near the ceiling of the bus interior and area easily visible by passengers sitting inside. You can provide the design, or Valley Metro staff can help you with the design work.



Billboard




VALLEY METRO STEM MAP





Valley Metro Type III Vehicle Ad Dimensions





The Fine Print

Some things to keep in mind about advertising with us:

- Spaces are available for a minimum of 6 months, but you get discounts for longer.
- The installation fee is a onetime fee billed at the time of installation
- We offer additional discounts to governmental organizations and nonprofits.
- We can't guarantee that an ad will remain on a specific bus or route for the duration of the contract.
- Design is the responsibility of the purchaser, but Valley Metro can assist in creating a design for a fee.
- All artwork needs to comply with generally accepted industry practice laws, and standards of good taste.



Materials

Our bus wraps are flexible, removable, and are self-adhesive, usually 3M or an equivalent that is designed to be durable and last for the entirety of your contract. The interior signs are full-color flexible, glossy card placards printed on card stock. All materials are selected for their high quality and durability. If you have the capability of supplying your own materials and/or doing the installation, we can discuss that option as well.
